CHARACTERISTICS OF COMMEMORATIVE COINS TO BE ISSUED BY THE BANK OF NAMIBIA TO COMMEMORATE NAMIBIA'S MARINE LIFE PROTECTION

In terms of Section 19(1) of the Bank of Namibia Act, 1997 (Act No. 15 of 1997), the Bank of Namibia hereby announces the characteristics of coins to be issued by the Bank and which have been approved by the Minister of Finance under Section 19(2) of the Bank of Namibia Act, 1997.

- 1. Coins will be issued in the following denominations:
 - 100 Namibia Dollars (N\$ 100)
 - 20 Namibia Dollars (N\$ 20)
 - 10 Namibia Dollars (N\$ 10)
 - 1 Namibia Dollar (N\$ 1)
- 2. On the obverse side of the coins the following features appear:

- (a) The Namibian National coat-of-arms.
- (b) The words "Republic of Namibia". (in capital letters)
- (c) the year 1998.
- 3. On the reverse side of the coins the following features appear:

A pictorial presentation of two whales in natural colours with the words "Marine Life Protection".

- 4. The N\$ 100 coin is made of gold, the N\$ 20 coin and N\$ 10 coin are made of silver and the N\$ 1 coin is made from cupro-nickel. The N\$ 100; N\$ 10 and N\$ 1 coins all have a diameter of 37 mm with a reeded edge. The N\$ 20 coin has a diameter of 64 mm with a reeded edge.


