DEVIATION OF A PORTION OF FARM ROAD 1795: DISTRICT OF GOBABIS: OMAHEKE REGION

In terms of section 22(2) of the Roads Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance 17 of 1972), it is hereby made known that the Minister has under section 22(1) (c) of the said Ordinance, in the district of Gobabis, deviated the portion of farm road 1795 described in paragraph

(a) of the Schedule and shown on sketch-map P2023 by the symbols A-B-C, from the route so described and shown, to the route described in paragraph (b) of the Schedule and shown on the said sketch-map by the symbols A-D-E.

The said sketch-map shall at all times lie open to inspection at the office of the Permanent Secretary: Works, Transport and Communication, Windhoek, during normal office hours.

#### **SCHEDULE**

- (a) From a point (A on sketch-map P2023) at the junction with farm road 1795 on the farm Remainder of Pembroke 94 generally north-north-eastwards and more and more north-north-westwards across the said farm to a point (B on sketch-map P2023) on the said farm; thence generally northwards and more and more north-north-eastwards across the said farm and the farm Westhavelland 93 to a point (C on sketch-map P2023) at the junction with district road 1792 on the last-mentioned farm.
- (b) From a point (A on sketch-map P2023) at the junction with farm road 1795 on the farm Remainder of Pembroke 94 generally east-north-eastwards near the southern boundary of the said farm to a point (D on sketch-map P2023) near the south-eastern corner of the said farm; thence generally north-north-westwards near the eastern boundary of the said farm to a point (E on sketch-map P2023) at the junction with district road 1792 on the said farm.

## INCREASE OF RATE OF INTEREST ON LOANS GRANTED UNDER THE ARGRICULTURAL CREDIT ACT, 1966

Under section 23(3)(c)(i) of the Agricultural Bank Amendment Act, 1991 (Act 27 of 1991), and with the concurrence of the Minister of Agriculture, Water and Rural Development, I hereby amend the terms and conditions of all loans granted in terms of the Agricultural Credit Act, 1966 (Act 28 of 1966) before the Agricultural Bank Amendment Act, 1991 came into operation on 23 December 1991, by-

- (a) increasing the interest rate chargeable on such loans with two percentage points affective from 15 June 1999, and thereafter-
  - (i) an additional two percentage points effective from 15 December 1999;
  - (ii) an additional two percentage points effective from 15 June 2000;
  - (iii) an additional two percentage points effective from 15 December 2000;
  - (iv) an additional two percentage points effective from 15 June 2001, and
  - (v) an additional two percentage points effective from 15 December 2001:

Provided that if on any occasion of an increase of the interest rate in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph, the increase will, in respect of any such loan, result in the rate of interest prescribed under section 51 of the Agricultural Bank Act, 1944 (Act No. 13 of 1944) in respect of advances made under that Act then being exceeded, the increase on such occasion in respect of such loan shall be limited to such percentage point as may be neccesary to bring the interest rate chargeable on such loan to a level which is equal to the rate of interest chargeable under the said section 51 in respect of such advances; and

(b) increasing, with effect from 15 June 1999, the rate of interest chargeable on arrear amounts in respect of capital instalments or interest payments on such loans to a

rate equal to the rate of interest prescribed from time to time in terms of section 51 of the Agricultural Bank Act No. 13 of 1944 in respect of advances made under that Act.
