EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 105 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC AND
TRANSPORT ACT, 1999

Under section 105 of the Road Traffic and Transport Act, 1999 (Act No. 22 of 1999), I –

- (a) exempt, in respect of any place within Namibia, the vehicles of the persons mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule, below, from regulations 336 and 338 of the Regulations promulgated under Government Notice No. 53 of 30 March 2001 on the condition that a disc, issued by the Deputy Director: Transportation Legislation Division on behalf of the Minister of Works, Transport and Communication, bearing the number indicated directly opposite that person, in column 2 of that Schedule, is displayed, in a conspicuous position, on the windscreen of the motor vehicle concerned; and
- (b) repeal Government Notice No. 252 of 15 December 2003 and Government Notice No. 2 of 3 January 2005.
